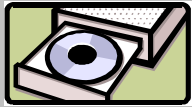

Barn Dance Postponed

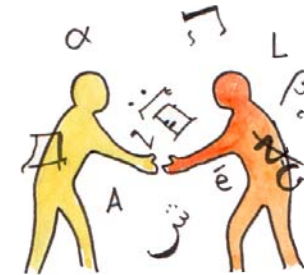
