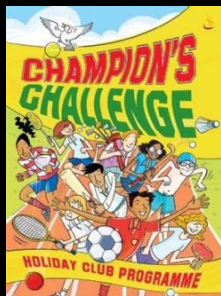
SUMMER BREAK *Most groups have now stopped meeting until September, if in doubt please contact the leader directly.*
