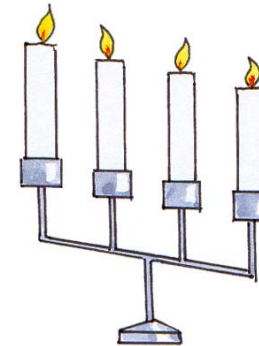
CRAWLEY OPEN HOUSE

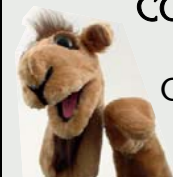
