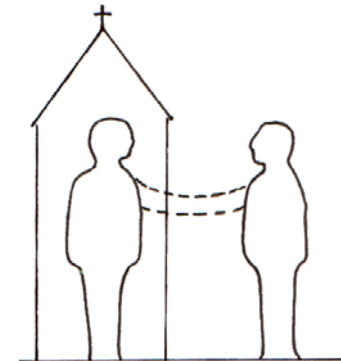
### CRAWLEY OPEN HOUSE

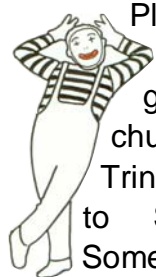
