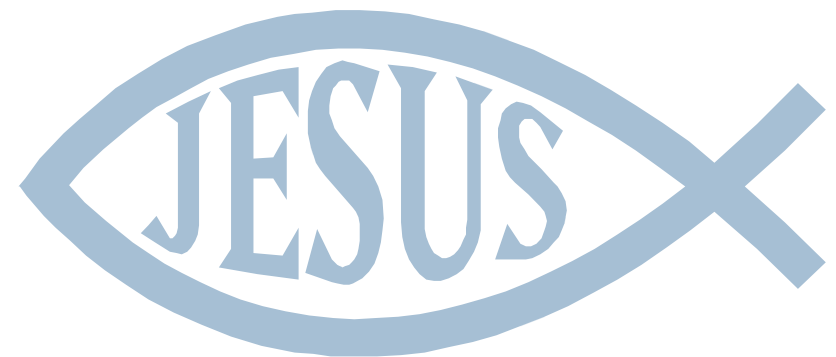
ASSISTANT ON FACEBOOK
