CRAWLEY OPEN HOUSE

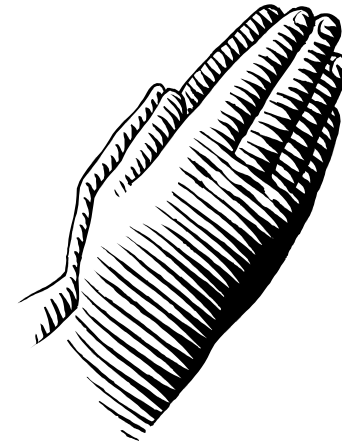
